What's on offer...

We the Curious is Bristol's science hub, full of **interactive exhibits** which are designed to make science fun and accessible to all. All exhibits are designed to spark curiosity and encourage hands-on exploration.

Tickets cover standard admission. For planetarium shows, you will need to purchase these tickets separately through the [We The Curious website](#). Please wait for us to confirm your tickets before booking the Planterium.

Other useful information...

We The Curious will allow entry for **up to 12 people**, subject to availability. Tickets are **first come, first served**, so book early if you have a specific date in mind. Please allow **5 working days** for processing.

When booking with Jessie May, you'll need to **provide an approximate arrival time**, but you can leave and re-enter on the same day.

We The Curious has a **Quiet Room** with low lighting, minimal sound, and **weighted blankets** available. They also run **Relaxed Mornings**—check out their website for dates.

A **Changing Places facility** is available. You'll need a **Radar key** (ask at the Welcome Desk if you don't have one) and **please** bring your own sling. For more details, visit [Access and Support | We The Curious](#).

Slimbridge WWT is a wetland nature reserve with **exciting wildlife encounters** for all ages. Whether it's getting up close with flamingos, pond dipping, or exploring Wellyboot Land and adventure playgrounds, there's something for everyone.

Our tickets cover general admission. Tickets for the canoe safari will need to be purchased separately. Please wait for us to confirm your tickets before booking any additional activities.

On any given day we arrange entry for up to **2 adults and 6 children**. Please give us **3 working days** notice in order to check availability and to arrange for your names to be sent to the Admissions Desk.

Slimbridge have **SEND-friendly sensory packs** available. These are available at the Admissions Desk. Please ask on arrival if this is something you want to make use of.

Slimbridge do have **seasonal activities** so be sure to check out their website before you visit.

Slimbridge's Changing Place is accessed via a Radar key. A key is available from the shop if needed. Further accessible information from Slimbridge can be found [here](#).

STEAM Museum



What's on offer...

The STEAM Museum brings **history, engineering, and science** to life in Swindon. Get up close to huge steam engines, try operating manual train signals, or even drive a locomotive. A perfect family day out next to the McArthur Glen Shopping Outlet!

Your tickets cover standard admission only but sadly do not include special event days such as the Swindon Railway Festival, Great Western Brick Show, or Christmas at STEAM.

When can I go...

Monday to Saturday -
10am -5pm with last
entry at 4pm

Sunday - 11am - 4pm
with last entry at 3pm

Closed
24th – 26th
December and 1st
January.

How do I get there...

STEAM – Museum of the Great Western Railway
Fire Fly Avenue (off Kemble Drive), Swindon, SN2 2EY

The nearest parking is at Swindon Designer Outlet. Both the North and West Car Parks are a five-minute walk from the museum.

For Sat Nav, use **'Kemble Drive'** for the North car park or **'Penzance Drive'** for the West car park. **Do not use the bus lane next to the West car park**—be warned, cameras are in use.

Standard parking charges apply; check out [McArthurGlen's website](#) for details. **Blue Badge holders** can scan the barcode on the back of their blue card to exit for free.

Other useful information...

We can arrange tickets for up to **2 adults and up to 4 children**. If one adult is a carer, this can increase to 3 adults. Children under 3 years old don't require a ticket, but still need to be registered.

Please provide **3 working days'** notice to check availability and arrange e-tickets.

A **Changing Places** facility is available at the Swindon designer outlet center nearby. Access is via an intercom button that connects you to security who will buzz you in.

There is plenty of free parking available. Accessible parking is on the right-hand side past the farm shop. The entrance is at the bottom of this car park.

We can arrange entry for 2 adults and 4 children with an additional adult if one person is a carer. Please allow 3 working days for us to check availability and to send you confirmation.

Bristol Zoo Project have **relaxed opening sessions** throughout the year. Please check out their website for exact dates and information. **Sensory bags** are also available from Visitor Information for those that might like to use them on any visit.

Check out BZP's [sensory map](#) which highlights quiet spaces, areas with known loud noises as well as interactive areas.

Bristol Zoo Project has an adult sized bench located in their First Aid Room which families are welcome to use but sadly no hoist is available. To access this room, please go to the Visitor Information to get the key. If you require a full changing place facility, the nearest one to BZP is at The Mall, Cribbs Causeway.
